Key Votes

- 1. UN Dues:** Hyde (R-IL) Amendment to the State Department Authorization bill to require that the United States be restored to its seat on the U.N. Human Rights Commission before the release of a final payment of \$244 million in U.N. back dues. Motion accepted 252-165, May 10, 2001. A no vote is a (+).
- 2. North Korea:** Hastings (D-FL) motion to recommit or amend the State Department Authorization bill to require the creation of a special envoy for Korea within the State Department. Motion rejected 189-239, May 16, 2001. A yes vote is a (+).
- 3. Missile Defense Testing:** Resolution to honor the U.S. military and defense contractors for the successful July 14, 2001, missile defense interceptor test. Resolution adopted 321-77, July 17, 2001. A no vote is a (+).
- 4. New Nuclear Weapons:** Markey (D-MA) amendment to the Defense Authorization bill to prohibit the use of funds for the development or study of nuclear earth penetrator weapon. Motion rejected 172-243, May 9, 2002. A yes vote is a (+).
- 5. Weapons in Space:** Tierney (D-MA) amendment to the Defense Authorization bill to prohibit funds for space-based national missile defense programs. Motion rejected 159-253, May 9, 2002. A yes vote is a (+).
- 6. International Criminal Court:** Paul (R-TX) amendment to the Defense Authorization bill to prohibit funds from being used to assist, cooperate with, or provide any support to the International Criminal Court. Motion accepted 264-152, May 10, 2002. A no vote is a (+).
- 7. Nuclear Tipped Interceptors:** Spratt (D-SC) motion to remove a provision from the Defense Authorization bill allowing for development of nuclear tipped missile defense interceptors. Motion rejected 193-223, May 10, 2002. A yes vote is a (+).
- 8. Weapons in Space:** Tierney (D-MA) amendment to the Defense Appropriations bill to delete funding for the space-based kinetic interceptor missile defense program. Motion rejected 112-314, June 27, 2002. A yes vote is a (+).
- 9. War in Iraq:** Resolution to authorize the use of United States Armed Forces against Iraq. Resolution adopted 296-133, October 10, 2002. A no vote is a (+).
