U.S. House of Representatives 109TH CONGRESS — COMBINED SESSIONS

1. Plan for withdrawing from Iraq – Woolsey (D-CA) amendment to express the sense of Congress that the President should develop and submit a plan for withdrawing U.S. troops from Iraq. Amendment rejected 128-300, May 25, 2005. *(Council supported the amendment.)*

2. Require Congressional authorization for military operations – DeFazio (D-OR) amendment to prohibit the administration from initiating military operations without Congressional authorization. Amendment rejected 136-280, June 20, 2005. *(Council supported the amendment.)*

3. Withholding of U.N. dues – Hyde (R-IL) amendment to withhold up to half of U.S. dues unless certain changes are made within U.N. Amendment adopted 226-195, July 19, 2005. *(Council opposed the amendment.)*

4. Space-based weapons ban – Kucinich (D-OH) amendment to begin U.N. negotiations for international treaty banning space-based weapons. Amendment rejected 124-302, July 20, 2005. *(Council supported the amendment.)*

5. Ask for Presidential reports to Congress on Iraq and clarification of U.S. Iraq policy – Menendez (D-NJ) motion to ask the President to advise Congress on benchmarks for a successful Iraq strategy. Motion rejected 203-227, July 20, 2005. *(Council supported the motion.)*

6. Missile Defense – Tierney (D-MA) amendment cutting \$4.7 billion from missile defense programs and barring further deployment of National Missile

Defense. Amendment rejected 124-301, May 11, 2006. *(Council supported the amendment.)*

7. Nuclear Reprocessing – Markey (D-MA) amendment to cut another \$40 million for the reprocessing of nuclear materials. Amendment rejected 128-295, May 24, 2006. *(Council supported the amendment.)*

8. Nuclear Non-Proliferation – Andrews (D-NJ) amendment to increase funding for the Global Threat Reduction Initiative (a non-proliferation program) by \$27.8 million. Amendment adopted 227-195, May 24, 2006. *(Council supported the amendment.)*

9. Iraq war – Hyde (R-IL) resolution endorsing President Bush's war in Iraq and opposing a withdrawal date. Resolution adopted 256-153, June 16, 2006. *(Council opposed the resolution.)*

10 Attack on Iran – Hinchey (D-NY) amendment requiring prior Congressional approval before the U.S. can launch an attack on Iran. Amendment rejected 158-262, June 20, 2006. *(Council supported the amendment.)*

11. Permanent bases in Iraq – King (R-IA) amendment to delete bill language barring permanent U.S. bases in Iraq. Amendment rejected 50-376, June 20, 2006. *(Council opposed the amendment.)*

12. Indian Nuclear Deal – Vote to approve the United States and India Nuclear Cooperation Promotion Act. Adopted 359-68, July 26, 2006. *(Council opposed the legislation.)*
